## Instructions to patient for collection of seminal fluid for post vasectomy analysis

- You should have a toxicity tested specimen container and instructions from your GP or clinician.
- The container and request form provided **MUST** be labelled with your **FULL NAME**, **DATE OF BIRTH** and the **DATE** and **TIME** of collection. **Unlabelled specimens will not be accepted**, so **please make sure that the specimen is clearly identified**.
- The specimen should ideally be collected in the morning and preferably delivered within 4 hours. If your doctor has requested that you bring a sample to the laboratory within **1 hour** of production, please contact Pathology Reception on 01392 402913 and inform them of the expected date and time of specimen delivery.



## Directions

- **Travelling along Barrack Road from Topsham Road**, go through the traffic lights, pass the hospital main entrance on your right, pass a second entrance to the hospital on the right, then take the next right turning into Church Lane. Take the second right turn into the hospital grounds. The Pathology building is the concrete grey four storey building on the left.
- Approaching from the city centre, from Heavitree Road turn right at the traffic lights into Barrack Road, go through the next traffic lights and take the next left into Church Lane. Take the second right turn into the hospital grounds. The Pathology building is the four storey building on the left.



Please note: The laboratory is open Monday to Friday 9-5pm only.

Submitting your samples for testing permits the use of any residual sample for quality control purposes.
